




Expenditures in Key Sectors


(as percent of Total, 2005-2015)













Poverty Reduction

Robust Economic Growth PHL GDP GROWTH FASTEST IN ASEAN









- Constructive Engagement and policies like BPA, FDP, Bottom-up-Budgeting, Citizen Participatory Audit, etc.




Bottom-up-Budgeting


