
## Budget Philosophy

The FY 2020 President's Budget aims to achieve the government's growth targets by investing in priority programs, including infrastructure and social services, while adhering to fiscal sustainability.



#### FY 2020 Proposed Budget, By Expense Item







The State shall assign the highest budgetary priority to education and ensure that teaching will attract and retain its rightful share of the best available talents through adequate remuneration and other means of job satisfaction and fulfillment.

Article VIII, Section 3 of the 1987 Constitution:

The Judiciary shall enjoy fiscal autonomy. Appropriations for the Judiciary may not be reduced by the legislature below the amount appropriated for the previous year and, after approval, shall be automatically and regularly released.

#### **EN BANC** A.M. No. 17-04-06-SC

"xx that the expenditures for the construction of the new halls of justice and court buildings enumerated below, whether they will be foreign-assisted or locally-funded projects, in included in the national budget for 2020, shall be considered as non -recurring expenditures and shall *not* form part of the Judiciary's appropriations that may not reduced by Congress under Article VIII, Section BA 2019 3rd Quarter Seminar 3 of the Constitution." 


